



# Rules & Regulations

## Team Rosters

The head coach of each team participating has been added into the All Star website, if you wish to change the team official who will be attending with your team please let me know so I can add them to the website. Once coaches have access to login, I will send an e-mail conformation to everyone on Tuesday July 12 the head coach will be able to login add your players participating directly into the roster.

Please click on All Star format (located on the front page of the website) to confirm the number of players you will be sending to participate for your team, as some age groups may differ.

When adding your players in please ensure you add their playing positions beside their name. This way all teams participating at All Star can ensure that they have goal keepers etc. Coaches will have contact info to reach out to other coaches participating on their team if they need too as well!

- Forward = FWD
- Mid = MID
- Defense = DFS
- Keeper = KP

## Coach Check in at All Star

One Team Official from each team will be required to pick up their All-Star jerseys prior to their scheduled game inside the West complex headquarters along with your printed game sheet.

Players Cards are not required for the competition, **Max 3 team officials are required on each team A and B for this event.**

**Score** No game results will be recorded.



## **Inclement Weather Procedures**

The City of Edmonton Field Conditions line will **NOT** be in effect for this tournament.

### **THE FIELD STATUS WILL BE UPDATED on the All Star website by 7AM ON THE EVENT DAY**

If HQ rules a game cannot be played, teams will be either asked to proceed directly to Penalty Kicks or will be notified of a rescheduled game date/time.

EMSA will work hard to ensure all games are played in some form, even if it means going to penalty kicks.

#### **If the weather is not cooperating:**

If the weather is considered dangerous (Thunder & Lightning in the area) at game time or any point during the game, Headquarters will ask the referee to postpone the game & teams must take shelter. Once it is safe to return to the field, teams will be asked to continue their games as promptly as possible. A decision may be made by Tournament Headquarters to shorten the game if necessary or go to Penalty Kicks. **DO NOT** leave the Complex without talking to Headquarters first or you risk forfeiting the game should it recommence once the storm passes.

Only as a last resort will penalty kicks be considered to decide a game. We will have considered the safety of players, the potential for permanent damage to the field, and whether there is the possibility of an alternative field the play can be moved to. If Tournament Headquarters makes the decision to decide the game by penalty kicks, standard penalty kick procedures will be followed.

***Only Tournament Headquarters will make the call to postpone or shorten games. Information will be relayed through the field marshal. Team representatives & referees will not cancel or postpone games without the permission of Tournament Headquarters.***

It is important to remember that Tournament Headquarters will make a decision with the best interest & safety of the children & spectators on the field. We thank you in advance for your understanding.

As soon as you hear thunder it is required to stop play and seek shelter  
**It is safe to resume the game 30 minutes after the last sound of thunder** (As Per ASA Rule)



## Discipline

If it is deemed that the red card offence was more serious in nature, teams will be contacted via e-mail and notified of any further discipline action or suspension.

## Equipment

1. NO NETS OR CORNER FLAGS ARE REQUIRED. EMSA WILL HAVE THE FIELDS READY FOR PLAY.
2. It is the responsibility of Team A to provide two proper game ball to the referee

★ If you are uncomfortable picking players from your team to go to the All Star Game, a few teams in the past have drawn names out of a hat or have had the players or coaching staff make an anonymous vote, teams have had mini skill competitions for players can win their spot into All Star. Just a few suggestions.

★ **U13 Girls/U13Boys/U15 Boys/ U15 Girls/ U17Boys teams require 1 team official from each team participating in the event to be present on the bench.** One team official must be the same gender as the team.

★ Each All Star team will have a total of **20 players**: 18 regular players and 2 keepers. Each keeper will play one half. During the half, the keeper not playing in goal is welcome to play out as a regular player. All players must receive approximately equal playing time.

★ Please note that it is the keeper's responsibility to bring their regular keeper jersey for use when they are in net. They will be supplied an All Star T-shirt for when they play out.

★ Player Cards are not required. **Coach cards ARE required for the All Star Game.**

★ The duration of the games will be the Outdoor standard for the teams' specific age group.

- U13 – 2 halves of 40 minutes
- U15 – 2 halves of 45 minutes
- U17 – 2 halves of 45 minutes



★ **Please keep in mind that the All Star Games are meant to be a fun time for all.** Let's have fun out there and not get too serious over the results of the event!

**A Reminder:**

This Tournament is for the enjoyment of all teams, and spectators should be reminded that they are there to support and encourage their team and fans and that respect should be shown for all players, coaches, and game officials. The tournament organizers have the right to remove any and all persons that are not showing sportsmanship either on the pitch or around the field/complex area. COACHES, PLEASE ENSURE YOU CONTROL YOUR TEAMS, YOUR TEAMS SPECTATORS, ETC...If issues do arise; the Tournament Director has the right to issue disqualifications for those teams involved.
